Dear Ms. Slater:

Thank you for letter of June 25, forwarding the June 18 Degginger, McBride, Sulkin, and Eaton response to our request for review of WSBA's dismissals.

The courts are part of our system of government. When offices of the court lie in judicial proceedings and use the justice system to enrich themselves, it is our right and duty to speak out. When those responsible for ensuring the good behavior of officers of the court (such as WSBA) refuse to discipline those who need discipline, it is our right and duty to speak out.

The documented proof of the misconduct is on file with your office. Please act on information, and disregard the self-serving characterizations of our reports as "name-calling."

In the Introduction of our June 20, 2014 Bar Complaint, we quoted judges, lawyers, and legal scholars who (like us) find grave ills in our justice system, and have reported them. Are these distinguished persons also engaged in "name-calling"?

Respondents find fault with our reference to Robert Grundstein, author of *Bad Minds. High Places. Cleveland Ohio to Washington State America's Archipelago of Legal Failure*, published by Amazon.com. Mr. Grundstein exposed a crooked judge in Ohio (that judge was later removed from office after an FBI raid.) On inactive status in Washington, Mr. Grundstein then attempted to protect his 93-year old mother's estate from the avaricious and wrongful claims by a WSBA lawyer. The result? WSBA held a Kanagoo Court on Mr. Grundstein. In order to contrive its desired and corrupt outcomes, WSBA removed all Grundstein's evidence from the record (42 exhibits) -- after which the Supreme Court refused to give him an appeal.
